Parts 1,2 , and 3 play these cells in any order, beginning sparsely and building in duration. Play anywhere in your range and extend phrases across your range ad lib.
Part 1 players enter first one at a time. After they have all entered, Part 2 players begin entering, followed by Part 3 players similarly.
Part 4 players play the written melody in unison, repeating 2 or 3 times as seems right for collective building of energy. Then everyone move to IV on cue.
