While Baltimore Club has been thriving for a couple of decades now, recently an influx of rappers have taken the sound of their city to their own music. Abdu Ali is one of the artists doing interesting things in this space and today releases a 45" titled Infinity Epiphanies on Baltimore's own Araca Records. Featuring production from Baltimore weirdo every-man Schwarz ("Say Something" and "Infinity Epiphanies") and Houston forward-pushing performer B L A C K I E ("Shiva"), it has a harsh electronics sound that has also been explored by other artists like Cities Aviv and Antwon.
