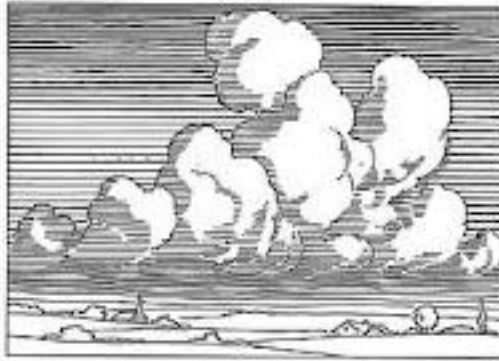


# How To Extract the Heart of a Cloud

There can be no denying the indisputability that each cloud is unique, both molecularly as well as emotionally; however, faithful adherence to the protocols outlined within are guaranteed\* to yield consistent results.

Discussed within the following pages one will find practically diagrammed solutions for the challenges faced in the extraction of the heart of a cloud.

There are two ways of going about extracting the heart of a cloud; the methodology employed stands wholly dependent upon the desired outcome of the extractionist.

Tools Certain to be Necessary:

- flattery
- charm
- condensation nuclei

First, there is the scientific method, known within the community as the Nepho-Cardiac Extraction. This method entails anesthesia, surgical implementation, and bedside manor; it results in consistent, sterile removal, leaving room for the possibility of later regeneration or, at worst, transplantation.

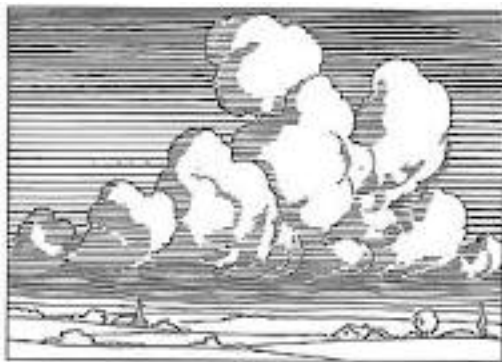
1 : The extractionist must install her/himself within the closest possible proximity to the cloud.
