Stop Making Sense Artistic Director November 2019

• Served as Artistic Director and Showrunner for a follow up event to 2018's last waltz. Cast and led a large group of musicians to play tribute to the Talking Heads' "Stop Making Sense" including a 6 piece core band, 3 horns, 2 backing vocalists, 2 dancers and 20 different lead singers. We rigged curtains, built risers, had lights & projections, arranged for costumes to be made, pointed 6 cameras at it and took a 32 channel recording. The show grossed ~\$12k over 2 nights, and everyone who worked on the show received a stipend and a large sum is being donated to our beneficiary Baltimore Harm Reduction Coalition.

- Served as showrunner to lead team to put on a two day festival at the Crown, Windup Space, & Ynot Lot. Forged partnerships, handled permitting (including alcohol), organized team meetings, wrote and managed budget, negotiated with venues, & promoted the event. Booked 60 acts on 5 stages in 2 days. Grossed \$11k and made ~\$500 in profit as a first year festival while paying every single person that worked on the show.
